**Dr. Harry E. Hickey**

**Professor, Fire Protection Engineering**

**University of Maryland**



After career and volunteer service in New York, including serving as the assistant fire coordinator for Wyoming County, Harry E. Hickey joined the University of Maryland's Department of Fire Protection Engineering (FPE) as the second full-time faculty member in 1960. He retired in 1985. The Dr. Harry E. Hickey Scholarship Endowment was established in July 2009. An important component of the FPE curriculum, the Fire Suppression Research Laboratory is named in his honor.

Upon retiring, Dr. Hickey served as Director of Fire Protection and Fire Chief at the Johns Hopkins University Applied Physics Laboratory in Howard County, Maryland. He has spent most of his adult life analyzing the key components of good fire protection. His pioneering concepts led to the creation of the NFHC to preserve the written history of fire protection and the fire services in America.
