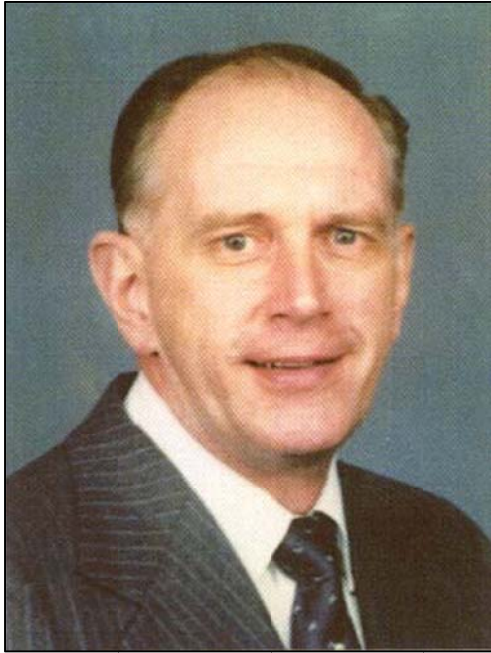


Hall of Legends, Legacies, and Leaders

Chief John W. Hogleund
Fire Service Educator

John W. Hogleund joined the University of Maryland Fire Service Extension in 1964, becoming its director in 1970. He led the effort to expand the Fire Service Extension into the Maryland Fire and Rescue Institute (MFRI) in 1975. Chief Hogleund led the development of the MFRI mobile teaching labs, and also the seven regional MFRI training centers. He also worked with the NFPA, IFSTA, and ISFSI on programs related to fire service education and training.

Chief Hogleund served as chief of the West Lanham Hills Volunteer Fire Department. He also served as president of the Maryland Fire Chiefs Association in 2000-2001, and continues to serve as chaplain of that organization. The Chief John W. Hogleund Staff and Command Training Scholarship was established by the MFCA in his honor.
